This position requires the completion of best practice and clinical literature searches, data collection, data analysis, manuscript writing/submission, research ethics board application writing/submission, project writing and other duties as required to complete program deliverables.

- Develop and implement evaluation plans to assess organizational, clinical and systemlevel outcomes from the implementation of health information technologies in different health care settings.
- Compile, analyze and interpret collected data
- Research and analyze clinical workflows and document clinical and organizational values derived from the implementation of health information technologies in primary care, and beyond
- Prepare written materials, including, but not limited to, case studies, papers/articles, proposals, presentations, abstracts and reports
